

## 2018 Stamo Latto Scholarship Announcement

Complete application due date: June 15.

Applicant requirements: 1) United States citizens. 2) High school senior women preferred, but academically strong junior women may also apply and even if awarded scholarships, may reapply as seniors. 3) Practicing Orthodox Christians who regularly participate in services and sacraments, particularly Holy Communion and Confession in canonical Orthodox parishes in metropolitan Memphis TN or Charleston SC, as certified by letter from parish priest.

Scholarship size: Average of \$1,000, range of \$500-\$1,000+, depending on qualifications and competition. Academic scholarships for students strong overall or in specific area(s).

Application documents: 1) The application form (below) completed by the applicant; 2) an essay (1-3 pp.) "Why I Want to Go to College," 3) a letter from the applicant's parish priest certifying that the applicant is a practicing Orthodox (i.e., regularly participates in services and the sacraments). Documents to be sealed and unopened when submitted: 4) a sealed high school transcript, including grades for the first semester of senior year, sent by US mail; 5) SAT scores submitted directly via U.S. mail by the College Board or by the high school as part of the transcript; 6) 3 sealed letters of recommendation on official school letterheads written by teachers and submitted by U.S. mail.
